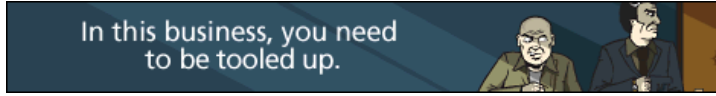

## Insurance to protect against driving law

Mobile insurance provider citymain has launched a new insurance policy to give people who lose their driving license due to new driving penalties reimbursement for alternative transport.

The Driving Ban Assistance (DBA) policy reimburses the policy-holder up to £1,000 per month for a maximum of 6 months for transport.

citymain said it only covered drivers who incur a maximum of three penalty points in an individual offence. 'We don't have to be dangerous drivers to collect enough points to put ourselves at risk of losing our licence.'

Driving Ban Assistance costs around £5.99 a month.
